UNEMPLOYMENT NUMBERS DECREASE FOR THE WEEK ENDING AUGUST 1

According to the **DOL's weekly unemployment claims report**, initial data shows 1,186,000, claims for the week ending August 1, this marks a decrease in applications after the previous two weeks saw an increase. The national unemployment rate was 11%; which is a decrease of 0.6% from the previous week's revised rate. The advance number for nationwide insured unemployment for the week of July 25 was 16,107,000; which is a decrease of 413,250 from the previous week.

According to initial data from the TWC, 61,940 claims were filed the week of August 1; which continues the trend of decreases in applications. Approximately 3.2 million unemployment claims have been filed in Texas since March 14. TWC is reporting on state unemployment numbers, including claims by industry and county, here.

In an industry notice, the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission <u>notified</u> <u>businesses</u> they can update their gross receipts to establish their business derives less than 51% from the sale of alcoholic beverages. This will allow businesses to qualify as a restaurant under GA-28, with the ability to provide dine-in services to the public. To qualify, businesses may fill out an Alcohol Sales Reporting Affidavit to include a calculation of gross receipts from April 1 through the date of submission. Alternatively, businesses that have changed their model to incorporate permanent food services, may apply for a Food and Beverage Certificate.
